We would like to announce the upcoming Conference on Function Theory on Infinite Dimensional Spaces, to be held in Madrid from 8th to February 11th, 2016. This year we hold the 14th edition of this conference which has taken place in the Departamento de Análisis Matemático of the Universidad Complutense on a biennial basis since 1989.

In the present edition special attention will be given, once more, to contributed talks. For this reason, several parallel sessions of 20-minute talks will be organized. All participants willing to deliver a short talk are kindly encouraged to register on-line for the conference and send a tentative title and an abstract of their talk to the Organizing Committee following the instructions given in the registration form of our web page

In addition to short talks, posters will be also accepted. Preference will be given to the following fields: geometry of Banach spaces, nonlinear analysis, differentiability, polynomials and multilinear mappings in Banach spaces, holomorphy, lineability and spaceability, hypercyclicity and dynamical systems. The Organizing Committee will try to schedule all the applications for contributed talks, but a selection procedure might be necessary if there is a large number of applications.
