FUNCTION THEORY ON INFINITE DIMENSIONAL SPACES XVI, MADRID 2019

We would like to announce with this letter the upcoming conference Function Theory on Infinite Dimensional Spaces XVI, to be held in Madrid between the 18th and 21st of November, 2019. This conference has been organized on a biennial basis by the Departamento de Análisis Matemático of the Universidad Complutense since 1989. The venue of this edition will be located in its traditional place at the Maths Building of the Universidad Complutense. As usual in the past editions, special attention will be given to contributed talks. For this reason, several parallel sessions of 20-minute talks will be organized. All participants willing to deliver a short talk are kindly encouraged to register on-line for the conference and send a tentative title and an abstract before the 1st of November, 2019. Preference will be given to the following fields: Geometry of Banach spaces, nonlinear analysis, differentiability, global analysis and analysis on metric measure spaces, polynomials and multilinear mappings in Banach spaces, holomorphy, lineability and spaceability, hypercyclicity and dynamical systems. The Organizing Committee will try to schedule all the applications for contributed talks, but a selection procedure might be necessary if there is a large number of applications.

All lecture rooms are equipped with blackboard and projector.
